## FOREWORD

We are pleased to present the Calhoun County Senior Millage 2009 *Annual Report*. This report provides information regarding the 2009 senior millage services and seniors who utilized them. In 2009 the Calhoun County Board of Commissioners awarded contracts of over \$2.6 M to area organizations to provide quality services to seniors residing in this county. The County also provides a Senior Prescription Discount Card Program which helps seniors pay for their prescriptions. With senior millage funds, the enrollment into the program is free and Calhoun County is the only known county that provides an *additional* discount for its seniors' prescriptions.

When the millage originally passed in November of 1996, the Calhoun County Board of Commissioners established the Senior Millage Allocation Committee. The Allocation Committee sets service priorities, service criteria, makes funding recommendations to the County Board of Commissioners and evaluates service programs. The Allocation Committee is composed of three Commissioners and 10 citizens. Each month, the Allocation Committee reviews reports of agencies' spending, geographic areas served, and program statistics. The members of this committee have volunteered countless hours to ensure that all senior millage dollars are spent to best meet the needs of Calhoun County seniors.

To assist the Senior Millage Allocation Committee with their mission, the Board established the Calhoun County Office of Senior Services in 1999. This office provides various reports regarding the millage programs and provides oversight of the senior millage contractors. For quality assurance purposes, the Office of Senior Services performs an annual assessment of each millage contractor. This on-site assessment reviews financial reports, program files, and unit counts to ensure vendors are in compliance with program and fiscal terms of the contract. All assessment reports are reviewed by the Senior Millage Allocation Committee and collaborative efforts are put in place to assure quality service delivery.

The Calhoun County Board of Commissioners and the Senior Millage Allocation Committee strive to ensure that our senior millage dollars are effective and efficient in meeting the needs of Calhoun County seniors. 
## History of the Calhoun County Senior Millage

- Nov. 5, 1996** Calhoun County voters approve “up to .75 millage levy” to provide senior services in Calhoun County to residents sixty (60) years of age and older.
- April 3, 1997** Board of Commissioners appoints citizens to the Senior Millage Allocation Committee whose role is to recommend allocations for senior millage funding of services for Calhoun County seniors
- June 5, 1997** Board of Commissioners approves contracting with Burnham Brook-Region III-B Area Agency on Aging as the administrative entity whose role is to provide administrative services to the Senior Millage Allocation Committee
- June 19, 1997** Board of Commissioners awards \$90,000 for home delivered meals; personal care, homemaking, and respite care for July through September of 1997 to allow seniors on waiting lists to get the services they need.
- October 23, 1997** Board of Commissioners awards \$1,515,708 for senior millage contracts for November 10, 1997 through December 31, 1998.
- Dec. 3 & 7, 1998** Board of Commissioners awards \$2,058,780 for senior millage contracts for January 1, 1999 through December 31, 1999.
- February 18, 1999** Board of Commissioners establishes the Office of Senior Services to administer the senior millage funds
- November 18, 1999** Board of Commissioners awards \$2,035,000 for senior millage contracts for January 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000.
- November 2, 2000** Board of Commissioners awards \$2,154,970 for senior millage contracts for January 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001.
- November 7, 2000** Calhoun County voters approve the senior millage renewal which allows up to .7473 mills for Senior Services. The millage runs through 2005.
- June 21, 2001** Board of Commissioners approves the implementation of the National Prescription Health Plan (NPHP) for county seniors. Senior millage dollars will be utilized to pay for seniors’ enrollment into the program and will provide an additional 15% of savings on these prescriptions (not to exceed \$250.00).
- August 1, 2001** Calhoun County Senior Prescription Program (NPHP) offers a prescription discount card to county seniors who do not have prescription coverage.
- November 1, 2001** Board of Commissioners awards \$2,215,210 for senior millage contracts for January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

- November 7, 2002** Board of Commissioners awards \$1,870,000 for senior millage contracts for January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.
- August 1, 2003** The additional discount that Senior Millage provides for its Senior Prescription Program is lowered from 15% to 10%.
- November 6, 2003** Board of Commissioners awards senior millage contracts for \$1,738,800 for January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004.
- August 1, 2004** Additional Board of Commissioner awards of \$ 51,041.00 are made to expand Legal Services and Congregate Meals and new contracts begin for Personal Emergency Response System, Adult Day Care, 211, and Hospice Respite Care.
- November 4, 2004** Board of Commissioners awards senior millage contracts for \$1,888,000 for January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005.
- November 3, 2005** Board of Commissioners awards senior millage contracts for \$2,000,000 for January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006.
- December 14, 2005** Office of Senior Services begins initiative offering one-on-one help to Medicare recipients in choosing among the available prescription plans offered through Medicare Part D.
- August 8, 2006** Calhoun County voters approve the senior millage renewal which allows up to .7452 mills for Senior Services. The millage runs through 2010.
- November 2, 2006** Board of Commissioners awards senior millage contracts for \$2,436,000 for January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007
- December 21, 2006** Board of Commissioners awards an additional \$195,000 for senior millage contracts for January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.
- November 1, 2007** Board of Commissioners awards senior millage contracts for \$2,663,000 for January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.
- November 13, 2008** Board of Commissioners awards senior millage contracts for \$2,649,726 for January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009.
- November 5, 2009** Board of Commissioners awards senior millage contracts for \$2,511,726 for January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010.


## 2009 Calhoun County Senior Millage Services Provided By Income of Participant
























