RESOLUTION: 2011-03

Local 9-1-1 Surcharge Recommendation

WHEREAS Calhoun County has enacted an E-911 Service Plan ("Plan") that establishes a service district consisting of all of Calhoun County in which E-911 services are provided to callers requesting emergency medical, police, and fire services;

WHEREAS the Calhoun County Consolidated Dispatch Authority ("CCFDA") has been designated by the Plan as the primary public safety answering point ("PSAP") for all of Calhoun County; and

WHEREAS the CCFDA supports and recommends the placement by the Calhoun County Board of Commissioners of a ballot proposition on the August 7, 2012 ballot allowing the citizens of Calhoun County a choice whether to fund 911 service in Calhoun County by a service charge placed on each device having access to 911 in Calhoun County or by each individual municipality in Calhoun County paying directly for the cost of 911 service;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, the CCFDA hereby formally requests that the Calhoun County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to MCL 484.1401b(1)(b), place a proposition on the August 7, 2012, ballot which would authorize a county-wide 9-1-1 surcharge to service users located in Calhoun County at a rate not to exceed \$2.25 per month;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, this body formally requests the following ballot language be placed on the ballot:

For the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2022 both inclusive, shall Calhoun County, Michigan be authorized to assess a county 9-1-1 charge on monthly billings to each service user located within Calhoun County at a rate not to exceed \$2.25 each month (if approved, replacing the current \$.60 surcharge), subject to annual approval by the Calhoun County Board of Commissioners, to be used exclusively for the funding of 9-1-1 emergency telephone call answering and dispatch services within Calhoun County, including facilities, equipment and operations?
