**NOTICE OF MEETING OF BOARD OF DETERMINATION**

**BLACKMORE DRAIN**

*Notice Is Hereby Given* to you as a person owning lands liable for an assessment or a public corporation subject to assessment, that the Board of Determination will meet on **Wednesday, July 9, 2014, at 3:00 PM at Battle Creek City Hall (City Commission Chambers), 10 North Division, Battle Creek, Michigan 49014** to hear all interested persons and evidence and to determine whether the Drain as prayed for in the petition dated June 17, 2014, for the maintenance and improvement of the Blackmore Drain pursuant to Act 40 of the Public Acts of 1956, as amended, is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare, and whether said Drain is necessary for the protection of the public health of the City of Battle Creek, and to further determine whether the addition and/or deletion of lands as recommended by a licensed engineer or surveyor will more accurately define the boundaries of the land benefitted by the Drain, and whether such addition and/or deletion of lands is just and equitable pursuant to Section 197 of Act 40 of the Public Acts of 1956, as amended.

A general description of the lands by section number proposed to be added or deleted as recommended by a licensed professional engineer or surveyor for the Drain is as follows:




