

1. **Per your threshold requirements you ask for a Certificate of Good Standing & Existence from the State of Michigan (etc), a City of Battle Creek Demolition License, and a Department of Energy, Labor & Economic Growth's Residential Builders' and Maintenance, Alteration Contractors' Board Residential Builder License. We are an out of town/state company and we would like to submit our certificate from our State and not submit the license from the Department of Energy. Furthermore, we would not acquire a local City demolition license unless we are considered for the work. We believe that this does not debar us from executing this work. Can you please clarify this?**

The Calhoun County Land Bank Authority has issued this RFP as an emergency procurement because of the condition of the building and risk to public safety.
