RE: QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS: RFB#123J-14 ROAD SIGNS & POSTS

The following information represents Calhoun County's official response to written questions received from potential bidders pertaining to RFB#123J-14. All respondents to this County solicitation are responsible for this information when submitting a bid for Road Signs & Posts. These replies in response to questions pertaining to the specifications as stated in RFB#123J-14 will become part of the final contractual documents upon the award of an agreement.

Written questions received by the deadline of *Tuesday, July 22, 2014* (as noted in RFB#123J-14, Sec. 2.4) have been answered below. Questions are stated in italics and the County's official response follows the question in bold.

Q#1: Are the requested U-channel posts green or galvanized?

A#1: green

Q#2: How many posts are generally ordered at one time?

A#2: Calhoun County: 350 each

Jackson County: 200 to 300 each

Q#3: Page 21- Are the HIP grade warning signs (W2-2, W14-2a, W14-2) decal or complete?

A#3: complete

Q#4: Page 21- Regarding HIP grade/pressure sensitive reflective sheeting, white p.s. 6"x150" and 9"x150". Does the '150' refer to inches or feet?

A#4: Feet

Q#5: Page 21- Regarding HIP regulatory signs, Complete Stop Ahead W3-1a is words only, W3-1 is the symbol. Which do you want?

A#5: symbol

Q#6: Will the County accept a bid for posts made of alternate materials?

A#6: The Road Department's specifications indicate a preference for aluminum posts. Should you choose to submit an alternate product, please reference Sec. 2.8 'Alternate Bids/Proposals' for instructions on doing so.
