**RE: QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS: *RFB#112J-14 Sodium Chloride***

The following information represents Calhoun County's official response to written questions received from potential bidders pertaining to ***RFB#112J-14***. All respondents to this County solicitation are responsible for this information when submitting a bid for sodium chloride. These replies in response to questions pertaining to the specifications as stated in ***RFB#112J-14*** will become part of the final contractual documents upon the award of an agreement.

Written questions received by the deadline of ***May, 14, 2014*** (as noted in ***RFB#112J-14, Sec. 2.4***) have been answered below. Questions are stated in italics and the County's official response follows the question in bold.

*Q#1: Is it OK to call for results after the bid opens?*

**A#1: Yes**

*Q#2: Is there a Bidders List available?*

**A#2: There will be after the bid opening.**

*Q#3: On page 3, Item 1.2 JOINT PURCHASING – The bid states that two (2) Counties Calhoun County and Jackson County have entered into a letter of understanding governing the procedure for joint purchasing by two Counties. Are the tons designated for the County locations specifically for that location or are all the locations sharing the total 41,000 tons?*

**A#3 Calhoun and Jackson are sharing the 41,000 tons. Estimated usage for each location is listed on Attachment C**

*Q#4 Please confirm that each County location is billed separately.*

**A#4 Billing for Calhoun should be sent to Marshall office only and for Jackson County billing should be sent to the Jackson office only.**
