**Administrative Order C37-2008-03J, D10-2008-06J, P13-2008-01J
Rescinds Administrative Order C37-2007-02J, D10-2007-03J and P13-2007-01J**

COURT HOLIDAYS - CALHOUN COUNTY TRIAL COURTS

IT IS ORDERED:

This administrative order is issued in accordance with MCR 8.110(D)(2)(a) (b) and (c) and MCR 8.112(b), effective January 1, 2009 and will continue indefinitely until revised by the courts and approved by the State Court Administrative Office. The purpose of this order is to coordinate holidays among the courts and to achieve uniformity with the local funding unit. The previous Administrative Order C37-2007-02J, D10-2007-03J and P13-2007-01J is rescinded effective December 31, 2008.

The following holidays will be observed by the courts in Calhoun County:

New Years Day, January 1;
Martin Luther King, Jr., Day, the third Monday in January in conjunction with the federal holiday;
Presidents' Day, the third Monday in February;
Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
Independence Day, July 4;
Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
Veterans' Day, November 11;
Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;
Friday after Thanksgiving;
Christmas Eve, December 24;
Christmas Day, December 25; and
New Year's Eve, December 31


When New Year's Day, Independence Day, Veterans' Day, or Christmas Day falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday. When New Year's Day, Independence Day, Veteran's Day, or Christmas Day falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be a holiday. When Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve falls on Friday, the preceding Thursday shall be a holiday. When Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve falls on Saturday or Sunday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday.


The courts in accordance with MCR 8.110(D)(2) and to achieve uniformity with the holiday practices of local governmental units, will also observe the holiday:


Good Friday Afternoon, beginning at noon

This Order is effective January 1, 2009.


