**BATTLE CREEK: Saturday, April 28th, from 10 am – 1:00 pm.**

**MARSHALL CITY: Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup>, from 10 am - 12 noon**

County Building parking lot on South Grand Street

**MARSHALL CITY: Saturday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, from 10 am – 12 noon**

County Building parking lot on South Grand Street

**BATTLE CREEK: Saturday, September 22th, from 10 am - 12 noon**

### ITEMS THAT CAN BE ACCEPTED (EXAMPLES)

Old gasoline, kerosene, fuel oil (must be in approved container)  
Brake fluid  
Pesticides  
Old prescriptions  
Herbicides  
Anti-freeze  
Solvents  
Cleaners  
Stain and oil base paint (Latex paint NOT accepted)  
Acids  
Pool chemicals  
Aerosol cans  
Batteries (flashlight, button, tool, computer)  
Mercury  
Other misc. products  
Fluorescent light bulbs  
CFL bulbs (compact fluorescent light) NOT BROKEN  
contains mercury

### ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

**Latex paint:** Latex paint is considered non-hazardous waste. Your waste hauler will take it with your trash pick-up provided it is in a solid form with the lid of the can removed. Mix kitty litter or sand in the paint and leave it in the sun to dry. Once the paint is solid, leave the lid off so the waste hauler can verify there is no liquid.
