Calhoun County Veterans' Millage

If approved, this proposal will authorize .01 mills to be levied by Calhoun County from 2013 through 2022, to provide funding of financial aid and services for Calhoun County veterans and to support the Calhoun County Veterans' Affairs Office and Veterans' Affairs Committee in providing services and financial aid to veterans.

Shall a .01 mill (1/10 of a mill, or 1 cent per \$1,000 of taxable value) increase on the limitation on the amount of taxes on the general ad valorem taxes (real and tangible personal property) within Calhoun County, State of Michigan, imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, from 2013 through 2022, both inclusive, for the purpose of providing financial aid and services to veterans as authorized by MCL §35.21, MCL §35.621 and MCL §35.801 and to support the Calhoun County Veterans' Affairs Office and the Calhoun County Veterans' Affairs Committee in their provision of financial aid and services to veterans? If approved and levied, the requested millage would provide estimated revenues of approximately Three Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$353,724) when first levied in 2013.
