Hazardous and toxic products and wastes shall be used and stored in compliance with Act 64, P.A. 1980, Act 188, P.A. 1965, to avoid health and environmental damage.

Waste shall be disposed of through a Michigan licensed hazardous waste hauler as contracted by a Health Department representative.

A record shall be kept of all materials shipped for disposal. A copy of the shipping manifest shall be kept on file in the Health Department.

All hazardous products and waste shall be stored to prevent cross contamination. Only like products shall be stored together.

The following list are examples of hazardous products or wastes as defined by EPA:
