Dear Local Unit of Government Leader:


The FireKeepers Local Revenue Sharing Board is pleased to announce that it has unallocated funding available to make discretionary grants for 2012 (grants will actually be made in early 2013). These grants can be made only to local units of government as defined in the application; however, applications can be made by local units of government that partner in creative ways with local non-profits. Grants will be made only to local units of government that are located in Calhoun County.

The FLRSB encourages creative applications that focus on multi-governmental and non-profit collaboration and that address funding projects that are worthy but for which complete funding is not available from other sources. While there is no requirement that any project be related to the FireKeepers Casino or the Tribal reservation to be funded, applicants are encouraged to identify any positive impact or relationship if one exists.

Applications are due by hand-delivery, fax or e-mail and must be received by 5:00 p.m. on December 28, 2012, and should be forwarded to Richard Lindsey, 315 West Green Street, Marshall, MI 49068, fax: (269) 781-0140, [rlindsey@calhouncountymi.gov](mailto:rlindsey@calhouncountymi.gov). The applications will be reviewed at the January 11, 2013, meeting of the FLRSB and the decision to fund will be made at that meeting or shortly thereafter. Notifications will be made in writing to all grant recipients.
